### **DISCUSSION AND DELIBERATION**

a. Bid Award - IFB 030124 - HVAC System at the City of Socorro Youth Center

Mr. Pineda stated that four bids were received and opened on March 1, 2024.

• Western Mechanical \$ 75,407.07

• MGS Refrigeration Heathing and Cooling, Inc. \$116,150.00

• E-Z-I Construction LLC \$110,000.00

• Jaramillo's Plumbing \$128,500.00

Mr. Pineda recommended the bid be awarded to the low bidder Western Mechanical.

Councilor Dean made a motion to award the bid to Western Mechanical. Seconded by Councilor Fleming.

b. Resolution No. 24-03-19 – Participation in FY 2024 State Road Fund Program

Donald Monette, City Administrator, stated the city was awarded \$125,000.00 in additional funds from the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Manzanares Avenue Street project.

Councilor Dean made a motion to approve Resolution No. 24-03-19. Seconded by Councilor Chavez-Lopez, motion passed unanimously.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Mayor Bhasker informed the Council that the city met with the New Mexico Environmental Department (NMED) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) earlier in the day. The EPA will move forward with the superfund site cleanup at Eagle Pitcher. The EPA asked the city for access to city land on the corner of Newberry Rd. and Lopezville Rd. to have the facility to treat and pump water for approximately 15 to 20 years into the pond located at the northwest end of Newberry Rd. EPA will clean up the Eagle Pitcher building that has asbestos and once cleaned the city will demolish it. Three additional wells will be drilled to help define the plume. EPA has committed to holding a public hearing to explain the process. The city is in the process of obtaining the property where the pond is located and will be used for the discharge of the contaminated water and the EPA will provide the city with a consultant to design a recreational park.

The mayor stated the CDBG project on Cuba Road is approximately \$400,000.00 short and the city will be applying for supplemental funding.

The city has received the two natural gas garbage trucks and three natural gas dump trucks that were obtained through the VW grant.

The city is working with the contractors of the two new projects at the Industrial Park to have the rock placed at the city's facility. The city is working with a vendor to trade the rock for base course.

The monument from the El Camino Real Historic Trail Site, located 30 miles south of Socorro, will be moved to the city's Industrial Park/Convention Center with the funding received from the legislative session.

The Rodeo arena enclosure is coming along and Dezirae Armijo, Tourism Director, and Cheyene Cortez, Asst. Tourism Director, have signed a major artist to perform at the rodeo arena on July 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Councilor Chavez-Lopez announced that Housing Authority representatives from around the state will come to Socorro to have training at the City of Socorro Convention Center in March and April and she is hoping to get Southwest Narrow to Socorro, which would have representation from six states for a full week of training.

Mayor Bhasker informed the Council that the land at the Industrial Park/Rodeo Complex will be surveyed for a planned subdivision that will need to be approved by the Council in the future. Administrator Monette stated he will meet with the surveyor and because the land is part of the original land grant it has no legal description. Once surveyed the city can move forward with the middle-income housing project.

Mayor Bhasker stated he received a letter from Socorro Electric Cooperative, Inc. (SEC) dated March 13, 2024, in response to a letter sent to SEC on January 23, 2024. The response letter did not, in good faith, answer the seven requests.
